*** Field Experiences:** Students complete supervised counseling practicum experiences that total a minimum of 100 clock hours over a full academic term. For internship, students must complete 600 clock hours of supervised counseling internship in roles and settings with clients relevant to their clinical mental health or school specialty area.
